1. Who was Andrew?

1.1 He was Simon Peter’s _____ – John 1:40

*“Andrew, Simon Peter’s **brother**, was one of the two who heard what John had said and who had followed Jesus.” John 1:40*

1.2 He grew up by the Sea of Galilee, in two cities:
_____ & _____ – John 1:44,

Mark 1:21,29

*“Philip, like Andrew and Peter, was from the town of **Bethsaida**.” John 1:44 // “They went to **Capernaum**, and when the Sabbath came, Jesus went into the synagogue and began to teach. ... As soon as they left the synagogue, they went with James and John to the home of Simon and Andrew.” Mark 1:21,29*

1.3 He worked as a _____ – Mark 4:18

*“As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were **fishermen**.” Mark 4:18*

1.4 Before following Jesus, Andrew was a disciple of _____ – John 1:35, 40

*“The next day **John** was there again with two of his disciples. ... Andrew, Simon Peter’s brother, was one of the two who heard what **John** had said and who had followed Jesus.” John 1:35,40*

*“The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and **said**, ‘Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!’ ... When he saw Jesus passing by, he said, ‘Look, the Lamb of God!’” John 1:29,36*

*“When the two disciples heard him say this, **they followed Jesus**.” John 1:37*

2.3 Andrew _____ who Jesus _____, Jn 1:38

*“**38** Turning around, Jesus saw them following and asked, “What do you want?” They said, “Rabbi” (which means “Teacher”), “where are you staying?” **39** “Come,” he replied, “**and you will see.**” John 1:38,39a*

2.4 He **INVESTED** _____ with Jesus, Jn 1:39b

*“So they went and saw where he was staying, and **they spent that day with him**. It was about four in the afternoon.” John 1:39b*
